This international exhibition of more than 100 models re-imagines the British beach hut for the first time in 300 years.

Some 240 architects, artists and designers from 15 countries entered a competition for commissions to build their designs on the Lincolnshire coast.

Alongside the scale models is a full-scale beach hut, Oyster Pleasance, which visitors can sit inside. It will be moved to the coast in September and will be available for daily public hire. Four other models selected as winners (including Michael Trainor's Come Up And See Me pictured) will also be installed.
